November 7 Election:

On a final note I would like to comment on the November 7 election. As many are aware there is one ballot item very important to the Future of Copper. Ballot Measure 5B is related to the approval for the Copper Mountain Consolidated Metro District (CMCMD) to secure financing for the future construction of a new fire station/district administration building at Copper. I fully support this important ballot initiative which has also been endorsed by the POLA Board of Directors.

To be eligible to vote in the District election, you must be a property owner at Copper, live in Colorado and be registered to vote in Colorado.
